## **RESOLUTION #6**

This Resolution adopted this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of July, 2012, by the Reed Township Board of Supervisors at their regularly scheduled meeting, said resolution stating as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to the Flood Plain Management Act of 1978, as amended and Section 3.03 C 5 of the Reed Township Floodplain Ordinance, Ordinance No. 2012-1, the Reed Township hereby imposes an administrative application fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) to accompany all applications for permits to undertake any construction or development within Reed Township for obtaining a permit from the Floodplain Administrator.
- 2. This application fee is in addition to any fee associated with an application for review of a subdivision and land development plan and it is in addition to any fee associated with a review pursuant to the Reed Township Stormwater Management Ordinance.
- 3. In addition to the administrative application fee, the applicant shall be responsible for all fees incurred by Reed Township for the review of documents submitted by the applicant for review in accordance to the Floodplain Ordinance and any inspection performed. This includes fees charged to Reed Township by the Floodplain Administrator, the code officer, the engineer and the solicitor (together the "Professional Consultants"). The rates to be paid by the applicant are the same rates charged to Reed Township by the Professional Consultants. These rates are amended from time to time.
- 4. Any review fees and/or inspection fees must be paid by the Applicant prior to the issuance of a permit or within 30 days of the date of invoice. Reed Township may, at its own discretion, require a monetary deposit based upon the Professional Consultants' estimate(s) of the cost associated with review for compliance with the Reed Township Floodplain Ordinance.
- 5. If Reed Township commences a civil action to recover any unpaid fees, costs, or other expenses incurred by applicant in the submission, review, and decision of the application and related documents and/or other submissions pursuant to the Reed Township Floodplain Ordinance, applicant shall be liable for court costs and reasonable attorney fees incurred by Reed Township.
- 6. This Resolution shall be effective August 2, 2012 and shall remain in force until modified, amended, or rescinded by the Reed Township Board of Supervisors, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania.
